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Education and Experience

Michelle Dorak earned her Master of Acupuncture degree from Southwest Acupuncture College in August 2018. This program consisted of 2,525 hours of education including 1,042 hours of clinical practice. She was certified as a Diplomate in Acupuncture by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in February of 2018. This included earning a certification in Clean Needle Technique. Michelle also completed the Level 1 Training, *Healing in a Community Trauma*, through Acupuncturists Without Borders, in January of 2018.

Michelle's training includes adjunctive therapies such as moxibustion, Tui Na, Shiatsu, cupping, auricular therapy, and trigger point therapy.

Michelle is a licensed acupuncturist in the state of Colorado. This licensure has never been suspended or revoked.

This clinic complies with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, including the proper cleaning and sterilization of needles and sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable factory-sterilized needles are used.
